What?	We are pleased to announce an <u>optional program</u> for artists to support an important cause as well as support sales. The Children's Theatre is a non-profit organization that inspires young people to read, write and think creatively. They share, encourage, and validate the creativity of children by performing original works of theatre, music and dance adapted from literature written by young authors; and has been selected for this festival. Artists may opt in by putting a special ribbon on one of their pieces. When this piece sells, 10% of the selling price goes to the non-profit. Artists simply fill out a form at the end of the show with the price and the 10% contribution and method of payment.

THE DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH	294 to Route 22 East. Go east, about 10 minutes, Go South on Route 41 (a four lane highway). Turn Left on Park Ave. The Highland Park Country Club will be on your left, just past the first stoplight.
FROM THE EAST	Coming from Eastern states, head towards Chicago, then proceed with directions from the South (see below).
FROM THE SOUTH	I-294 West to Deerfield Road East exit. Exit at Deerfield Road East. Drive 10 - 15 minutes. Get on Highway 41 going North. Take the next right onto Park Avenue. The Highland Park Country Club will be on your left, just past the first stoplight.
FROM THE WEST	I-290 East to I-294. Go direction Milwaukee (north on a map) but marked West on signs. Exit at Deerfield Road East. Drive 10 - 15 minutes. Get on Highway 41 going North. Take the next right onto Park Avenue. The Highland Park Country Club will be on your left, just past the first stoplight.
FROM CHICAGO	I-90/94 West. Continue on I-94 West. At juncture where I-94 goes to Milwaukee, follow US 41 North, to Waukegan. Turn right at the first stoplight, Park Ave. The Highland Park Country Club will be on your left, just past the first stoplight.

THE DETAILS

ACCESSIBILITY	Every effort is made to make our festivals open access events for artists and the public. If you have special needs, please call the office, 847-926-4300, prior to the festival or notify any on-site staff.
ARTIST BREAK ROOM	There will be food available for all artists for all three days of the show. The artist break room will also feature water, coffee and snacks all weekend.
AWARDS	Judging will take place Friday.
BREAK DOWN	At the festival's conclusion on Sunday night at 5pm you may begin to take down your booth. Anyone breaking down before 5pm will not be invited to participate in the festival again. Once your booth is broken down, you will be given an exit pass and allowed to bring your vehicle back to the loading zone at staff discretion.
ELECTRICITY	All booths will have electricity.
FEST RULES	 Artist(s) must be present, no reps in their place All work must be original. No buy/sell. All work and booth displays must be in line with juried images No webbed lawn chairs allowed, in or behind the booth.

	 No sleeping in tent or in festival area overnight No smoking in the festival area, in or around your booth. No chairs or sitting in the walking lane
PARKING	Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available. ARTISTS MUST PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. You will receive a coded parking permit and map at check-in. Please place this on the dashboard of your vehicle's driver side.
SAFETY & SECURITY	The Highland Park Country Club will be locked an hour after the event ends until 7am the following day. Please use good judgment when securing your belongings for the evening. Amdur Productions does not accept responsibility for your property.
TAX RATE	Illinois tax forms are available on our website, amdurproductions.com. The sales tax rate in Highland Park is 8%.

Amy's Tips for the Bling Jewelry & Gift Show in Highland Park

1. Have a **second person** with you to assist with set up, working the booth, give you a chance for a break (bathroom, food, etc). Limited booth sitting will be available by Amdur Productions staff.

- 2. Bring a **good dolly**. If you don't have one, this would be a great time to get one. My favorite type is the kind that converts to a wheeled cart or a stand up dolly. Put your name on the dolly before you come to the fest as they all look alike.
- 3. Load in is by flights. Come at your flight time and pace yourself. No rushing required.
- 4. At the fest, water will be available in the Artist Break Room/Festival Office. Be sure to **drink plenty of** water and stay hydrated.
- 5. Enjoy Highland Park: Visit different shops and restaurants.
- 6. Send out festival postcards by US mail, or eblast the pdf to your lists.
