## Green Ribbon Project

<b>What?</b>	The Deer Park Art Show will feature an <u>optional program</u> for artists to support sales and also support an important cause. <b>PADS Lake County</b> has been selected as the non-profit for this festival. Artists may opt in by putting 1-4 special ribbon(s) on their art. When this piece sells, 10% of the selling price goes to the non-profit. Artists simply fill out a form at the end of the show with the price and contribution and make the contribution directly.
<b>Why?</b>	The public feels good buying this special piece knowing some of the proceeds goes to the cause. You sell the art!

## THE DIRECTIONS

<b>From the North</b>	Take US 12 E/N US Highway 12. US 12 E becomes N. Rand Road.
<b>From the South</b>	Take I- 294 N towards Milwaukee. Merge onto I-290 W toward Rockford/US 20/IL 64. Take IL-53 toward Kirchoff Road. Take the exit on the left toward W. Lake Cook Road. Merge onto Lake Cook Road. Turn slight right onto N. Rand Road/ US-12W. Destination will be on your left.
<b>From the West</b>	Take I-90 E toward Chicago/East. Take the IL-59 exit. Turn left onto IL-59/ N Sutton Road. Turn slight right onto W. Dundee Road/ IL-68. Turn left onto W. Long Grove Rd/ County Hwy-43/ County Hwy- A49. Take the 2 <sup>nd</sup> right. Turn left.
<b>From the East</b>	Take I-90 W/I-94 W/ Kennedy Expy W toward O'Hare-Rockford. Keep left to take I- 90 W/ Jane Addams Memorial Tollway W toward Rockford/ I-294 N/Milwaukee.

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Merge onto IL-53 N toward Northwest Suburbs. Take the exit on the left toward west Lake Cook Rd. Merge onto Lake Cook Rd. Turn slight right into N. Rand Rd/ US-12 W.

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## THE DETAILS

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<b>ACCESSIBILITY</b>	Every effort is made to make our festivals open access events for artists and the public. If you have special needs, please call the office, 847-926-4300, prior to the festival or notify any on-site staff.
<b>ARTIST BREAK ROOM/ FEST OFFICE</b>	Same location as check-in, announced via email one week prior to the festival. The artist's break room features snacks, restrooms, and a great place to refresh all weekend.
<b>BREAK DOWN</b>	<p>An <b>exit pass</b> system will be used for artists. When you have boxed and crated your art, <i>and have taken down your booth</i>, you will receive a pass from circulating festival staff. This pass will allow you to drive back into the festival area as during set-up.</p> <p>All artists may choose to dolly out after 5pm.</p>
<b>FEST RULES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Artist(s) must be present, no reps in their place</li><li>• All work must be original. No buy/sell.</li><li>• All work and booth displays must be in line with juried images</li><li>• All booths must be safe, overhangs at 7 feet or higher, &amp; <b>MUST BE WEIGHTED DOWN</b></li><li>• No more than 2 people working a booth per 10 x 10</li><li>• No webbed or slung lawn chairs allowed, in or behind the booth.</li><li>• No sleeping in tent or in festival area overnight</li><li>• No cars/trucks allowed in festival area.</li><li>• No motorized vehicles in festival area</li><li>• No smoking in the festival area, in or around your booth.</li><li>• No chairs or sitting in the paved walking lane</li></ul>
<b>PARKING</b>	Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available. Maps and parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please duct tape a parking permit to it.
<b>SECURITY</b>	Security will be on-site overnight, patrolling the festival area. However, they cannot be everywhere at once. Please use good judgment when securing your tent and belongings for the evening. Amdur Productions does not accept responsibility for your property.
<b>SAFTEY</b>	<p>When driving into the festival area at load in or load out:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Keep your windows down, radio off</li><li>• Keep flashes on</li><li>• Drive slowly- watch for children, dogs and people in area</li></ul>
<b>TAX RATE</b>	Illinois tax forms are available on our website, <a href="http://amdurproductions.com">amdurproductions.com</a> . The sales tax rate in Deer Park is <b>7.25%</b> .
<b>WEIGHTS &amp; TENTS</b>	<b>All tents must be weighted properly and be white. You will need 40lbs per leg. NO CINDER BLOCKS ARE ALLOWED. NO WATER JUGS ARE ALLOWED! Amdur Productions is unable to provide weights of any type on site. Artists without tent weights will not be allowed to use a tent.</b>

### Amy's Top Tips for the Deer Park Art Show in Deer Park

1. Have a **second person** with you to assist with set up, working the booth, give you a chance for a break (bathroom, food, etc). Limited booth sitting will be available by Amdur Productions staff.
2. Bring a **shade awning** for behind your tent as most booths have back space. Wear sunscreen from dawn to dusk and reapply.
3. Bring a **good dolly**. If you don't have one, this would be a great time to get one. My favorite type is the kind that converts to a wheeled cart or a stand up dolly. Put your name on the dolly before you come to the fest as they all look alike.
4. At the fest, water will be available in the Artist Break Room/Festival Office. Be sure to **drink plenty of water** and stay hydrated.
5. **Be prepared for inclement weather.**
6. Eblast of **weights and weigh down your tent** or stake down WHEN YOU SET UP YOUR TENT.
7. Send out **festival postcards** by pdf to your lists.
8. Lift from the legs.
