If you cannot make the Friday night flight time, you may set up Saturday at 10am.

THE DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH	Take Highway 94 and exit at Old Orchard Road. Go East on Old Orchard Road to 2 nd light and turn right (south) on Skokie Blvd. Go to south end of mall, in front of Nordstroms and you are there.
FROM THE WEST	Take 290 to Golf Road and go east on Golf to Skokie Blvd. You are at the

festival corner.

THE DETAILS	
ACCESSIBILITY	Every effort is made to make our festivals open access events for artists and the public. If you have special needs, please call the office, 847-926-4300, prior to the market or notify any on-site staff.
ARTIST BREAK ROOM	Same location as check-in. The artist's break room features snacks, restrooms, and a great place to refresh all weekend.
BREAK DOWN	At the market's conclusion on Sunday night at 5pm you may begin to take down your booth. Anyone breaking down before 5pm will not be invited to participate in the festival again. Once your booth is broken down, you will be given an exit pass and allowed to bring your vehicle back to the loading point you used at set-up.
CHECK-IN	Location will be announced one week prior to the market via email. Artists must check-in in person with a valid government issued ID.
FEST RULES	 Artist(s) must be present, no reps in their place All work must be original. No buy/sell. All work and booth displays must be in line with juried images All booths must be safe, overhangs at 7 feet or higher, & MUST BE WEIGHTED DOWN No more than 2 people working a booth per 10 x 10 No webbed lawn chairs allowed, in or behind the booth. No sleeping in tent or in festival area overnight No cars/trucks allowed in festival area. No motorized vehicles in festival area No smoking in the festival area, in or around your booth. No chairs or sitting in the paved walking lane
PARKING	Aree parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available. Maps and parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please duct tape a parking permit to it.
SECURITY	Security will be on-site through out the festival and overnight, patrolling the festival area. However they cannot be everywhere at once. Please use good judgment when securing your tent and belongings for the evening. Amdur Productions does not accept responsibility for your property.
SAFTEY	 When driving into the festival load in or load out area: Keep your windows down, radio off Keep flashes on Drive slowly- watch for children, dogs and people in area
SET-UP	Dates/Times are above. All artists must DOLLY-IN . Please remember to bring a dolly/push cart. Closest entry points will be given to you at check in. Artists will drive to entry point area and off load. Please bring your dolly or wheeled cart. We will provide assistance with our "carry-all" motorized vehicles to those who need and request assistance at check-in. Please remember to bring adequate weights . See "weights" under general information in the beginning of this packet for more info.

TAX RATE	Illinois tax forms are available on our website. The sales tax rate in Skokie is 10.25%.
WEIGHTS & TENTS	All tents must be weighted properly and be white. You will need 40lbs per leg. NO CINDER BLOCKS ARE ALLOWED. NO WATER JUGS ARE ALLOWED! Amdur Productions is unable to provide weights of any type on site. Artists without tent weights will not be allowed to use a tent.

Amy's Top Ten Tips for the North Shore Art Market in Skokie

- 1. Have a **second person** with you to assist with set up, working the booth, give you a chance for a break (bathroom, food, etc). Limited booth sitting will be available by Amdur Productions staff.
- 2. Wear sunscreen from dawn to dusk and reapply.
- 3. Bring a **good dolly**. If you don't have one, this would be a great time to get one. My favorite type is the kind that converts to a wheeled cart or a stand up dolly. Put your name on the dolly before you come to the fest as they all look alike.
- 4. Come at your flight time and pace yourself. No rushing required.
- 5. At the fest, water will be available in the Artist Break Room/Festival Office. Be sure to **drink plenty of water** and stay hydrated.
- 6. Enjoy Highland Park: Visit the Ravinia.org for concerts, shows, festivals, and family fun.
- 7. Eblast **festival postcards** by pdf to your lists.
- 8. Be prepared for inclement weather.
- 9. Bring lots of weights and weigh down your tent or stake down WHEN YOU SET UP YOUR TENT.

10. Lift from the legs.
