CHECK-IN	Exact location will be announced one week prior via email. Follow on-site signage. Artists much check-in in person with valid government issued ID. <u>Friday, August 11: 3pm-5pm</u> : Please park ONLY in the designated check-in lot just east of the Egg Harbor Restaurant on Old Half Day Rd. Do not bring your car into the festival area before 3 pm so that we can be sure all of the public's cars are removed. <u>Saturday, August 12: 6am-8am</u>

THE DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH	Go south on I-94 to Illinois. Go South on I-94 to Route 22 (Half Day Road). Go West on Route 22. Route 22 will fork about 3 miles west of the Toll Road. Take the right fork which is Olde Half Day Road. A large red brick Village Hall is situated at the point of the fork in the road. The art festival will be just 1/4 mile ahead on the right.
FROM THE SOUTH	Go North on I-94 (towards Milwaukee) to Route 22 (Half Day Road). Go West on Route 22. Route 22 will fork about 3 miles west of the Toll Road. Take the right fork which is Olde Half Day Road. A large red brick Village Hall is situated at the point

	of the fork in the road. The art festival will be just 1/4 mile ahead on the right.
FROM THE WEST	Go East on I-88 to I-294. Go north on I-294 to I-94. Go Northwest on I-94 to Route 22 (Half Day Road). Go West on Route 22. Route 22 will fork about 3 miles west of the Toll Road. Take the right fork which is Olde Half Day Road. A large red brick Village Hall is situated at the point of the fork in the road. The art festival will be just 1/4 mile ahead on the right.

THE DETAILS	
ACCESSIBILITY	Every effort is made to make our festivals open access events for artists and the public. If you have special needs, please call the office, 847-926-4300, prior to the festival or notify any on-site staff.
ARTIST BREAK ROOM	Same location as check-in. The artist's break room features snacks, restrooms, and a great place to refresh all weekend.
AWARDS	Judging will take place Saturday. Ribbons are distributed Sunday.
BREAK DOWN	At the festival's conclusion on Sunday night at 5pm you may begin to take down your booth. Anyone breaking down before 5pm will not be invited to participate in the festival again. Once your booth is broken down, you will be given an exit pass by a circulating staff member. This pass will allow you to bring your vehicle back into the area. Traffic will be one way. Vehicles without an exit pass will not be allowed entry. Artists may choose to dolly out any time after 5pm.
FEST RULES	 Artist(s) must be present, no reps in their place All work must be original. No buy/sell. All work and booth displays must be in line with juried images All booths must be safe, overhangs at 7 feet or higher, & MUST BE WEIGHTED DOWN No more than 2 people working a booth per 10 x 10 No webbed lawn chairs allowed, in or behind the booth. No sleeping in tent or in festival area overnight No cars/trucks allowed in festival area. No motorized vehicles in festival area No smoking in the festival area, in or around your booth. No chairs or sitting in the paved walking lane
PARKING	FOR CHECK IN ONLY: Park in the check-in lot just east of the Egg Harbor Restaurant, which is on Olde Half Day Rd. FOR FESTIVAL: Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicles is available at the nearby artists parking area, located across the festival on Milwaukee Avenue at the College of Lake County. Complimentary shuttle runs before, throughout and after the festival for your convenience. Parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please tape a parking permit to it.
SECURITY	Security will be on-site overnight, patrolling the festival area. However, they cannot be everywhere at once. Please use good judgment when securing your tent and belongings for the evening. Amdur Productions does not accept responsibility for your property.
SAFTEY	When driving into the festival area at load in or load out:

	 Keep your windows down, radio off Keep flashes on Drive slowly- watch for children, dogs and people in area
TAX RATE	Illinois tax forms are enclosed in this package. The sales tax rate in Lincolnshire is 7.0%.
WEIGHTS & TENTS	All tents must be weighted properly and be white. You will need 40lbs per leg. NO CINDER BLOCKS ARE ALLOWED. NO WATER JUGS ARE ALLOWED! Amdur Productions is unable to provide weights of any type on site. Artists without tent weights will not be allowed to use a tent.

Other Lincolnshire Area Restaurants include Cheesecake Factory (on Aptikisic just west of Milwaukee, south of the festival), Flemings (high-end steakhouse-near corner of Milwaukee and Aptikisic on west side), McDonald's (just south of Olde Half Day Road on Milwaukee, west side of street), Potbelly Sandwich Works (a bit further south on Milwaukee, at the City Park Center, west side)

Amy's Top Ten Tips for the Lincolnshire Art Festival

- 1. Have a **second person** with you to assist with set up, working the booth, give you a chance for a break (bathroom, food, etc). Limited booth sitting will be available by Amdur Productions staff.
- 2. Bring a **shade awning** for behind your tent as most booths have back space. Wear sunscreen from dawn to dusk and reapply.

- 3. Bring a **good dolly**. If you don't have one, this would be a great time to get one. My favorite type is the kind that converts to a wheeled cart or a stand up dolly. Put your name on the dolly before you come to the fest as they all look alike.
- 4. Load in is by flights. Come at your flight time and pace yourself. No rushing required.
- 5. At the fest, water will be available in the Artist Break Room/Festival Office. Be sure to **drink plenty of water** and stay hydrated.
- 6. **Enjoy Highland Park**: Visit Ravinia.org for concerts, shows, festivals, and family fun. Try the nearby Marriot Lincolnshire Theater for Theater in the round.
- 7. Eblast **festival postcards** by pdf to your lists.
- 8. Be prepared for inclement weather.
- 9. Bring lots of weights and weigh down your tent or stake down WHEN YOU SET UP YOUR TENT.
- 10. Lift from the legs.
