We are pleased to announce an <u>optional program</u> for artists to support an important cause as well as support sales. The Lung Cancer Alliance is the oldest and leading non-profit organization dedicated to saving lives and advancing research by empowering those living with and at risk for lung cancer; and has been selected for this festival. Artists may opt in by putting a special ribbon on one of their pieces. When this piece sells, 10% of the selling price goes to the non-profit. Artists simply fill out a form at the end of the show with the price and contribution and method of payment.
The public feels good buying this special piece knowing some of the proceeds goes to the cause. You sell the piece.

CHECK-IN	Friday, May 20: 9pm-10:30pm Saturday, May 21: 6am - 9am Location will be announced one week prior to festival via email. Artists must check-in in person with a valid government issued ID.
SET-UP	Please see amdurproductions.com for your booth number. If you cannot make the Friday night flight time, you may set up Saturday morning but you MUST be set up before the opening Saturday at 9am. All artists must DOLLY-IN. Show location is in the INTERIOR outdoor courts of the center. Friday, May 20: 9pm-midnight. Artists who wish to set up in this time MUST check-in by 11pm and wear the badges found in their check-in pack to be cleared by security. Saturday, May 21: 6am - 9am. Set up MUST be complete by 10am.

THE DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH	Take 94 E to 294 S: Take 88 W towards Aurora. Get off on 83. Continue onto Spring Rd and take a left into the Oakbrook Center.
FROM INDIANA	Take 65 N to 294 N. Take 88 W toward Aurora. Get off on Route 83. Continue onto Spring Rd and take a left into Oakbrook Center.
FROM THE SOUTH	Take 57 N to 294 W. Take 88 W toward Aurora. Get off on Route 83. Continue onto Spring Rd and take a left into Oakbrook Center.

THE DETAILS

ACCESSIBILITY	Every effort is made to make our festivals open access events for artists and the public. If you have special needs, please call the office, 847-926-4300, prior to the festival or notify any on-site staff.
ARTIST BREAK ROOM	Same location as check-in. The artist's break room features coffee, water, snacks, restrooms, and a great place to refresh all weekend.
AWARDS	Judging will take place Saturday. Ribbons are distributed Saturday afternoon or Sunday.
BREAK DOWN	At the festival's conclusion on Sunday night at 6pm you may begin to take down your booth. Anyone breaking down before 6pm will not be invited to participate in the festival again. Once your booth is broken down, you will be given an exit pass and allowed to bring your vehicle back to the loading point you used at set-up.
CHECK-IN	Location will be announced one week prior to the festival via email. Artists must check-in in person with a valid government issued ID.
FEST RULES	 Artist(s) must be present, no reps in their place All work must be original. No buy/sell. All work and booth displays must be in line with juried images All booths must be safe, overhangs at 7 feet or higher, & MUST BE WEIGHTED DOWN No more than 2 people working a booth per 10 x 10 No webbed lawn chairs allowed, in or behind the booth. No sleeping in tent or in festival area overnight No cars/trucks allowed in festival area. No motorized vehicles in festival area No smoking in the festival area, in or around your booth. No chairs or sitting in the paved walking lane All booths must be white only No exterior signage or flags allowed
PARKING	Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available. Maps and parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please duct tape a parking permit to it.
PERMIT	The Village of Oak Brook does not require a permit.

SECURITY	Security will be on-site through out the festival and overnight, patrolling the festival area. However they cannot be everywhere at once. Please use good judgment when securing your tent and belongings for the evening. Amdur Productions does not accept responsibility for your property.
SAFTEY	When driving into the festival area at load in or load out: Keep your windows down, radio off Keep flashes on Drive slowly- watch for children, dogs and people in area
SET-UP	Dates/Times are above. All artists must DOLLY-IN . Please remember to bring a dolly/push cart. Closest entry points will be given to you at check in. Artists will drive to entry point area and off load. Please bring your dolly or wheeled cart. We will provide assistance to those who indicate it on their registration form prior to the festival. Please remember to bring adequate weights . See "weights" under general information in the beginning of this packet for more info.
TAX RATE	Illinois tax forms are available on our website. The sales tax rate in Oak Brook is 7.75%.
IN ADDITION	When you sellAsk the customer if you can take a picture for our Collector's Wall. Just take a picture with your phone and email it to Jill@AmdurProductions.com with your name and their name. It's that easy!
WEIGHTS	All tents must be weighted properly and be white. We recommend at least 40 lbs per leg. Amdur Productions is unable to provide weights of any type on site. Artists without tent weights will not be allowed to use a tent. Staking is never allowed into a paved street, lot, park, shopping center, or sidewalk. No flags or signage may extend from your tent.

Amy's Top Ten Tips for the Spring Art Festival in Oak Brook

- 1. Have a **second person** with you to assist with set up, working the booth, give you a chance for a break (bathroom, food, etc). Limited booth sitting will be available by Amdur Productions staff.
- 2. Bring a **shade awning** for behind your tent as most booths have back space. Wear sunscreen from dawn to dusk and reapply.
- 3. Bring a **good dolly**. If you don't have one, this would be a great time to get one. My favorite type is the kind that converts to a wheeled cart or a stand up dolly. Put your name on the dolly before you come to the fest as they all look alike.
- 4. Come at your flight time and pace yourself. No rushing required.
- 5. At the fest, water will be available in the Artist Break Room/Festival Office. Be sure to **drink plenty of water** and stay hydrated.
- 6. **Enjoy Oakbrook**: Visit the Drury Lane Theater for a play. 630.530-0111
- 7. Send out **festival postcards** by US mail, or eblast the pdf to your lists.
- 8. Be prepared for inclement weather.
- 9. Bring lots of weights and weigh down your tent or stake down WHEN YOU SET UP YOUR TENT.
- 10. Lift from the knees.
