## **Gold Coast Art Fair**

When: June 16-17 Where: Grant Park Hours: 10 a.m.-6 p.m. daily Admission: Suggested donation \$5

Why Go: The festival is home to more than 300 artists who work in various mediums and whose works range in price from \$25 to \$25,000. There will be live demonstrations from artists, speed-painting and interactive art projects.





#### Millennium Art Festival

When: July 6-8

Where: Lake Street east of Michigan Avenue

Hours: Friday 11 a.m.-6 p.m.; Saturday 10 a.m.-6 p.m.; Sunday 10 a.m.- 5 p.m.

Admission: Free

Why Go: This is the festival's 10th year. People can interact with artists through demos and booth chats. There will also be live music and food.



### Southport Art Festival

When: July 14-15
Where: Southport Avenue from Waveland Avenue to Grace Street
Hours: Saturday 10 a.m.-7 p.m. and Sunday 10 a.m.-5 p.m.
Admission: Free
Why Go: This acclaimed festival has art of all mediums. TimeOut Chicago rated

the festival as one of the city's best.
