Here's What You Need to Know

Are You Demonstrating On Site? Let us know so we can talk about it in our community outreach!

Bring A Water Bottle!

In our new initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have cold water available to refill your water bottle.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and will be behind your booth. Please share with your neighbor(s).

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens. **No cinderblocks or water jugs allowed as weights.**

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

Check-In Info

Friday, September 7

Flight One: 6pm-7pm, All ODD Numbered Booths
Flight Two: 7:30pm-8:30pm, EVEN Numbered Booths

Check-in will close at 8:30pm. Set-up may continue. Artists who want to check in after that point must call our festival phone to notify us. Phone number is 224-253-2330.

Saturday, September 8

6am-8am: All Artists. Vehicle entry as allowed. Check-In will close at 8am. Set-up must be completed by 9:30am.

How Load In Works

Every artist will:

Pull up to their space location

Unload everything in their space

Park their vehicle in the designated artist parking area

Return to their booth space and set up

All artists should not set up their booth until their car has left the festival grounds.

Parking

Parking for vehicles and trailers 7' and under will be in a garage at 212 N Milwaukee St, Milwaukee, WI 53202. Every artist will receive 3 parking vouchers for this garage to be used throughout the weekend as needed.

Parking for vehicles and trailers over 7' will be limited and on Menomonee Street at the south end of the festival. Parking permits and maps will be available at check in.
