Hello Chicago Botanic Garden Art Festival Artist,

We are excited to have you exhibit your art at the Chicago Botanic Garden Art Festival, Friday, June 29, Saturday, June 30 & Sunday, July 1, 2018!

Here's What You Need to Know

Bring A Water Bottle!

In our new initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have cold water available to refill your water bottle.

Botanic Themes, Materials, and Uses REQUIRED

All artists must exhibit art with botanic themes, materials, or art that can be used in a botanic way. 75% of your booth display must comply with this requirement.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by **two** 10x10 tents. **10x20 tents are NOT allowed.**

Tent Weights - NO STAKING

THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO STAKING IN TENTS TO THE GROUND. Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens. NO CINDERBLOCKS OR WATER BOTTLES USED AS WEIGHTS ALLOWED.

General Rules of Chicago Botanic Garden

- There is no smoking at the Chicago Botanic Garden, including e-cigarettes.
- Service animals are permitted on Garden grounds. No other pets may be on the grounds or left in vehicles.
- Bikes are allowed on the east road only.
- Rollerblading, skateboarding, use of scooters and Frisbees, ball playing and fishing are not permitted.
- Balloons are a hazard to wildlife on the grounds and are not permitted.
- Concealed carry firearms are prohibited on any real property under the control
 of the Forest Preserves of Cook County. Individuals who are licensed to carry
 concealed guns must store their firearms in their car's glove compartment,
 trunk, or locked case while visiting the Garden.
- There is no overnight parking allowed at the Garden.
- Tents can only be 10x10. No 10x20 tents are NOT allowed.

No staking into the ground.

How to get there

Check-in will be at a tent located in Parking Lot 6. Enter the Chicago Botanic Garden off Lake Cook Road, stop by the Gatehouse and then turn left at the first stop sign. The address of the Chicago Botanic Garden is 1000 Lake Cook Road, Glencoe, IL 60022.

Check-in/Load-in Times

The Load In schedule is attached to this email. Everyone must load in at their designated time on Friday. All artists must be done setting up by 3:30PM to be ready for the Member's Only Preview starting at 4PM. This includes removal of all trash and/or packaging materials from your booth. If you have any questions, please let me know.

How Load In Works

Every artist will:

Pull up in the loading area

Use a dolly to bring all of their items to their space

Park their vehicle in Lot 3

Walk back to their space

Set-up their booth

Please do not set up your booth until your car is parked in the Artist Parking

Parking Friday ONLY

Artists may park in Lot 3. Be sure to hang your parking permit in your vehicle. If you plan to drop your hitch, please request an extra permit at check-in and duct tape this to your hitch. Please remember that your hitch may be dropped here Friday only – must be moved to south end for Saturday and Sunday.

Parking Saturday & Sunday

Use the Dundee Road entrance on the south side of the Garden and follow signs to artist parking. Take the free shuttle to/from festival site/Regenstein Center West Portico all day. Please allow yourself an extra thirty minutes to park and get to the festival. Your booth must be staffed and open each day 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Even if you are a Garden member, you must park at the south end. Each parking spot can turn over at least

three times per day. A parking spot taken by you can turn away at least three customers.

The Chicago Botanic Garden has a member base of 51,000 households and all are invited to this exclusive event featuring you and your art. Dress will be summer casual. Show and sell. You must remain in your booths until the 7 p.m. closing time.

There will be a complimentary artist tram ride of the Gardens at 8:30 a.m. Saturday morning. Pick up the tram in front of the Visitor Center.
