Bring A Water Bottle!

In our new initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have cold water available to refill your water bottle.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and extend no more than 4' from the booth, where space is available.

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens. No cinderblocks or water jugs allowed as weights.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

<u>Check-In Info</u> Friday, August 10 Flight One: 3pm-4pm: 101-126, and even numbered booths 38-50 and 183-195. Drop and Drive. Set up may continue as late as artists need.

Flight Two: 4:30pm-5:30pm: 51-63, 153-176, Odd numbered booths 38-50 and 183-195. Set up may continue as late as artists need.

Check-in will close at 5:30pm. Artists who want to come after that point must call our festival phone to notify us. Phone number is 224-253-2330.

Saturday, August 11

6am-8am: All Artists. Vehicle entry as allowed. Check-In will close at 8am. Set-up must be completed by 9:30am.

How Load In Works

Every artist will: Pull up to their space location Unload everything in their space Park their vehicle in the designated artist parking Return to their booth space and set up <u>All artists should not set up their booth until their car has left the festival grounds.</u>

Parking

FOR CHECK IN ONLY: Park in the check-in lot just east of the Egg Harbor Restaurant, which is on Olde Half Day Rd.

FOR FESTIVAL: Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicles is available at the nearby artists parking area, located across the festival on Milwaukee Avenue at the College of Lake County. Complimentary shuttle runs before, throughout and after the festival for your convenience. Parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please tape a parking permit to it.
