Create a poster that you think best represents the Village of Glencoe and recognizes the 150 years of Glencoe's existence

Poster contest guidelines:

- Use your favorite media (paint, pencil, collage, photography, mixed media, etc.)
- Must include a reference to the 150th anniversary of the Village of Glencoe, either directly or indirectly.
- Finished size 11"x 17" without frame or mat, landscape or portrait orientation.
- Must submit a digital jpeg (300dpi) file of your artwork to Info@AmdurProductions.com **and** deliver the original to the Village of Glencoe at Village Hall. You can drop off or mail in the original to Village Hall.
- Submissions must be labeled with Name, Address, Phone, Email, Age Group and the Title, along with the signed rules and regulations form.

Entries are categorized by age group.

1. Youth K-8
2. High School/College ages 14-22yrs old
3. Adult 23 and Over

The deadline for submission is June 20, 2019
