## Bring A Water Bottle!

In our new initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have cold water available to refill your water bottle.

## <u>Storage</u>

Must be tidy and not extend more than 4' past your space, not blocking sidewalks or stores.

## Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

## Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. Weight inspections will occur

before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens. NO CINDERBLOCKS ALLOWED.

Flight 1: 5:30pm-6:30pm: EVEN Numbered Booths 1-38, all booths 41-83.5. Flight 2: 7:00-8:30pm: ODD Numbered Booths 1-38 and all booths 84-119 Flight 3: 8:00: 13, 14, 16 and 17 Flight 4: 9:PM 12 Check-In will close at 8:30pm. Artists may continue to set up.

#### Load-In Saturday, June 22

6am-8am: All Artists. Vehicle entry as allowed. Check-in will close at 8am. All artists must be ready to open at 9:30am for show opening at 10am.

## How Load In Works

Every artist will:

- 1. Pull up near their booth space
- 2. Unload all of their items to their space
- 3. Park their vehicle in Artist Parking
- 4. Come back to their space
- 5. Set-up their booth

\*\*Please do not set up your booth until your car is parked in the Artist Parking\*\*

Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available. Maps and parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please duct tape a parking permit to it.
