Green Ribbon Project

If you are participating and the piece you designate for the Green Ribbon Project sells, 10% of the sales from that piece of art will be donated to Greater South Loop Association and South Loop Neighbors.

<u>Are You Demonstrating On Site?</u> Let us know so we can talk about it in our festival advertising! <u>Bring A Water Bottle!</u>

In our new initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have cold water available to refill your water bottle.

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 50 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. We encourage all artists to make the weights look professional and not use cinderblocks or water jugs. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist who does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and extend no more than 4' from the booth, where space is available.
