Bring A Water Bottle!

In our new initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have cold water available to refill your water bottle.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and will be behind your booth. Please share with your neighbor(s).

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. **No cinderblocks or water jugs allowed as weights.** Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

<u>Awnings</u>

Awnings are allowed in all booth locations.

BOOTHS 31, 33, 121 and 121.5 can set up in Flight Two

Flight Three: 8:30pm-9pm: Booths 60.1, 60.2, 60.3, 60.4, 106.1, 106.2, 106.3, 106.4, 81.1-81.4

How Load In Works

Drive in slowly with your windows down and your hazards on Pull up to their space location Unload everything in their space Park their vehicle in the designated artist parking area Return to their booth space and set up <u>All artists should not set up their booth until their car has left the festival grounds.</u>

Parking

Parking for vehicles and trailers 7' and under will be in a garage at 212 N Milwaukee St, Milwaukee, WI 53202. Every artist will receive 3 parking vouchers for this garage to be used throughout the weekend as needed.

Parking for vehicles and trailers over 7' will be **limited** and on Menomonee Street at the south end of the festival and allowed on specific side streets. Parking maps and permits will be available at check in.
