Bring A Water Bottle!

In our new initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have cold water available to refill your water bottle.

<u>Storage</u>

No indoor storage on site. Artists in booths 45-107 should plan on having storage within their space.

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 50 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. NO staking allowed. No cinderblocks or water jugs allowed as weights. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

Park their vehicle

Come back to their space and set-up their booth

Do not set up your booth until your car is out of the loading lane

Regular Garage Parking

There are a lot of close garages in the area. The closest is 240 E Illinois St, Chicago, IL 60611.

Oversize Parking

There is an oversized parking at 430 N Rush St, Chicago, IL 60611. This is the closest one that I know of. If you go onto Wabash and head south, there are some on the east side of the street.

RV Overnight Parking
