## Here's What You Need to Know

### Green Ribbon Project

If you are participating and the piece you designate for the Green Ribbon Project sells, 10% of the sales from that piece of art will be donated to Bright Pink. ## Bring A Water Bottle!

In our new initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have cold water available to refill your water bottle.

## Storage

Back storage must be tidy and extend no more than 3' from the booth or shared with the space behind you, where space is available.

### Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. **No cinderblocks or water jugs allowed as weights.** Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens.

### Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

## <u>Awnings</u>

Awnings are allowed in all booth locations.

Check in will be in a tent in the parking lot across the street from Town Hall. Approximate address is 675 Village Ct, Glencoe, IL 60022. Look for our yellow Artist Check In signs to help guide you!

## Check-In Info

#### Friday Evening, July 24

Flight One: 6pm-7pm, Drop and Drive. Booths 2-17, 30-39, 45-53, and 110-141 Set up may continue as late as artists requires.

Flight Two: 7:30pm-8:30pm, Booths 19-28, 61-68, 73-106, 143-156. Set up may continue as late as artists require

Flight Three: 8:30pm-9pm, Booths 18, 40-43, 55-57, 70-72, 142 Set up may continue as late as artists require.

**Check-in will close at 9pm**. Artists who want to come after check-in closes must call our festival phone to **notify us during check-in hours**. Phone number is 224-253-2330.

### Saturday, July 25

6am-8am: All Artists. Vehicle entry as allowed. Check-In will close at 8am. Set-up must be completed by 9:30am.

## How Load In Works

Every artist will: Check-in and get credentials, parking **OUTSIDE** of the festival footprint. Drive in slowly with your windows down and your hazards on Pull up to their space location Unload everything in their space Park their vehicle in the designated artist parking Return to their booth space and set up <u>All artists should not set up their booth until their car has left the festival grounds.</u>

## <u>Parking</u>

Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available. Maps and parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please duct tape a parking permit to it. Artists MUST display their festival parking permits given at check in. Police will ticket all vehicles in the artist parking that do not show their permit!
