Congrats! You're one of the selected artists to exhibit at the **Art Walk at the Glen**, August 1-2, 2020! Show hours are 9AM to 5PM on Saturday and Sunday.

Here's What You Need to Know

Important Guidelines

- Wear a face covering
- Have hand sanitizer in your booth
- Clean your area often
- Control who is in your booth: Only one attendee OR family/friend group at a time in your booth. We will indicate a "que" for any other people wanting to come into your booth.
- All booths are corner booths so utilize your outside walls for more exposure!
- No flip bins are allowed, you can show matted pieces on the walls and sell from there.
- Have a transfer table area where you place the sold art, and where the customer picks it up from. A tall stool can work for this too.
- We encourage you to take cashless pay systems and credit cards.
- If you aren't feeling well, are waiting for covid test results, please do not attend.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and extend no more than 4' from the booth, where space is available.

Food and Beverage

Lots of places from Starbucks to sit down restaurants are in the area. Due to covid protocols, we will not be providing beverages or snacks this year.

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. No cinder blocks or water jugs allowed as weights. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens.

Awnings

Awnings are allowed in all booth locations.

Set Up: Saturday, August 1

5am-8am: All Artists. Vehicle entry as allowed. Check-In will close at 8am. Cars must be off the venue by 8:30am. Set-up must be completed by opening 9am.

How Load In Works

Every artist will:

Check-in and get credentials, parking OUTSIDE of the festival footprint.

Drive in slowly with your windows down and your hazards on

Pull up to their space location

Unload everything in their space

Park their vehicle in the designated artist parking area (very close by)

Return to their booth space and set up

All artists should not set up their booth until their car has left the festival grounds.

Parking

Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available.
