

Hello Barrington Art Walk Artists,

We're excited to see you at the **Barrington Art Walk**, September 12 and 13, 2020! Show hours are **9AM to 5PM** on Saturday and Sunday.

****We're updating the load-in information. Because of the layout and tight space, please bring a dolly. We will do our best to get artists close to their booth space but please be ready to dolly to your space if need be.****

Here's What You Need to Know

Important Guidelines

- Wear a face covering over nose and mouth while at the Art Walk
- Have hand sanitizer in your booth for you and shoppers
- Clean your area often
- Control who is in your booth: Only one attendee OR family/friend group at a time in your booth.
- All booths are corner booths so utilize your outside walls for more exposure!
- No flip bins are allowed for the public to flip through, you can show matted pieces on the walls and sell from there.
- Have a transfer table or area where you place the sold art, and where the customer picks it up from. A tall stool can work for this too.
- We encourage you to take cashless pay systems and credit cards.
- If you aren't feeling well, are waiting for covid test results, please do not attend.

Artist Reception

To show their appreciation to all the artists, the Village of Barrington invites the artists to a small reception after the show on Saturday! The reception will be after the show approximately at 5PM on Saturday on the festival grounds.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and extend no more than 4' from the booth, where space is available.

Food and Beverage

Due to covid protocols, we will not be providing beverages or snacks this year.

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. No cinder blocks or water jugs allowed as weights. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone

safe. No nailing into the ground. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens.

Set Up: Saturday, September 12

5am-8am: All Artists. Vehicle entry as allowed but **NOT** guaranteed. **Please bring a dolly!** Check-In will close at 8am. Cars must be off the venue by 8:15am. **Set-up must be completed by opening at 9am. If you need an earlier set up time, please let us know so we can coordinate.**

How Load In Works

Every artist will:

Check-in and get credentials, parking OUTSIDE of the festival footprint.

Pull up close to their space location. We will be working together to make it as easy as possible for all artists, however, **please be aware that the space is tight and artists may need to dolly.**

Unload everything in their space WITHOUT setting up.

Park their car in the designated locations in and near the Art Walk

Return to their booth space and set up

Parking

Free parking for all artists will be on site or at a nearby location. Location will be explained at check in.

Promote, Promote, Promote!

Pre-promotion is EVERYTHING! Attached to this email is a digital file of the festival poster for your emails blasts. Email this poster to your client list and invite them to the Barrington Art Walk! There is plenty of free parking for all your clients!
