Here's What You Need to Know

Safety First!

All artists should have hand sanitizer in their booths and keep their booth sanitized. All booths will be 6' a part. Artists are welcome and encouraged to dress the outside of their booths!

Donate Your Art

Home is Where the HeART Is! We invite you to bring your gently used art to the fest and donate it to The Chicago Furniture Bank. They're truly making a difference by distributing furnishings to those leaving shelters and moving into permanent housing. Help them turn empty spaces into cozy homes! Bring donations to the Chicago Furniture Bank truck, Saturday 10am-3pm.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and extend no more than 3' from the booth, where space is available.

Tent Weights

NO STAKING. Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. No cinder blocks or water jugs allowed as weights. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and

throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

Awnings

Awnings are allowed in all booth locations.

Check-In and Load-In Saturday Morning on May 22

6am-8am: All Artists. Check-In will close at 8am. **Set-up must be completed by opening at 9:30am on Saturday. If you need an earlier set up time, please let us know so we can coordinate.**

How Load In Works

THIS IS A DOLLY-IN SHOW. Please bring a dolly! We will not have any available.

Every artist will:

Pull up curbside close to their booth space

Dolly all of their items to their space. (Booths 46-59 will be able to pull up next to their spaces)

Park their vehicle in artist parking

Come back to their space and set-up their booth

****Please do not set up your booth until your car is parked in the Artist Parking****

Parking

Oversized and regular day and overnight parking will be available. We will show you where to park when you check in. Parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please ask for an additional permit at checkin and duct tape the parking permit to it.
