Here's What You Need to Know

Safety First!

All artists should have hand sanitizer in their booths and keep their booth sanitized. All booths will be 6' a part. Artists are welcome and encouraged to dress the outside of their booths!

Donate Your Art

Home is Where the HeART Is! We invite you to bring your gently used art to the fest and donate it to The Chicago Furniture Bank. They're truly making a difference by distributing furnishings to those leaving shelters and moving into permanent housing. Help them turn empty spaces into cozy homes! Bring donations to the Chicago Furniture Bank booth, Saturday 10am-3pm.

Are You Demonstrating On Site?

Awnings

Front awnings must be 2' or shorter. No front awnings longer than 2' are allowed in all parts of the festival. Side awnings and back awnings are allowed as long as you are not intruding on your neighbors space.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and extend no more than 4' from the booth, where space is available.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 40 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and

throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist that does not comply with these rules will be required to fix it before the festival opens.

How to get there

Check-in will be in Port Clinton Square. The suite number is 123. GPS address is 600 Central Avenue, Highland Park, Illinois 60035. Follow our yellow check-in signs to help guide you to the office location.

Staging before your Flight

All artists will stage their vehicles in the Metra Parking lot off of St. John's Avenue, on the south end before checking in and bringing their vehicles onto the venue. Attached is the parking lot map. GPS address is 1700 St Johns Ave, Highland Park, IL 60035

How Load In Works

Every artist will:

Check-in and get credentials, parking **OUTSIDE** of the festival footprint.

Drive in slowly with your windows down and your hazards on

Pull up next to their booth space

Unload all of their items to their space

Park their vehicle in the designated artist parking

Come back to their space

Set-up their booth

Do not set up your tent before your vehicle is off of the festival grounds.

Parking

Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available. Maps and parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please duct tape a parking permit to it.
