We are excited to have you exhibit your art at the **Port Clinton Art Festival**, August 23-24, 2025 in Highland Park, Illinois! Show hours are 10am to 5pm on both days.

Here's What You Need to Know

Check-In and Load-In Times

Friday, August 22
3:30PM-4:30PM: All booths in the 400 block, Even Numbers 500-528 & Odd Numbers 501-539
5:30PM-6:30PM: Even Numbers 528.1-544 (midline booths on the 500 block) & All booths in the 300 block
7:30PM-8:30PM: All booths in the 100, 200 & 600 block

Check in will close at 8:30PM on Friday night. Artists who want to come after 8:30PM on Friday must call or text our festival phone 847-238-2242 and let us know.

Saturday, August 23

6AM – 7AM: ALL Booths can set-up HOWEVER artists will have limited access to drive to their space due to closing of the entrances.

ALL artists must be checked in by 7am on Saturday. All vehicles should be parked in Artist Parking by 8am.

Booth Number

Check-In Location

Check-in will be in Port Clinton Square. GPS address is 600 Central Avenue, Highland Park, Illinois 60035. Follow our yellow check-in signs to help guide you to the office location. Please park outside of the barricades and then come to the check in office.

Load-In Instructions

Park **OUTSIDE** of the festival footprint Check-in and get credentials Drive in slowly with your windows down and your hazards on Pull up next to your booth space Unload all of your items to their space Park your vehicle in the designated artist parking Come back to your space Set-up their booth **Do not set up your tent before your vehicle is off of the festival grounds.** In order for load-in to work, ALL artists must drop their belongings at their booth space, remove their car, and then set up their tent/display. Please be a part of a smooth load-in by following these rules.

Rental Tents & Rental Pro Panels

Artists who have rented a tent and pro panels may have to wait longer to set up. It takes time to set up the tent and then set up the panels. If you can set up Saturday morning, that could be a better option.

ProPanel Renters

Parking

Free parking, including overnight and oversized vehicle parking will be available. Maps and parking permits will be distributed at check-in. If you plan to drop your hitch, please duct tape a parking permit to it.

Storage

Back storage must be tidy and extend no more than 3' from the booth, where space is available.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent.

Tent Weights

Every tent will need to have AT LEAST 60 pounds per tent leg and strong straps or rope to attach the weights to the tent. No cinder blocks or water jugs allowed as weights. Weight inspections will occur before the festival opens and throughout the festival to keep everyone safe. Any artist who does not comply with these rules will be required to fix the problem before the festival opens.

Corner and Double Space Requirements

An artist with a corner must either have the corner wall open or use the outside wall to display art. Double spaces must be occupied by two 10x10 tents OR one 10x20 tent, unless pre-approved by the festival committee.

Awnings

Awnings are allowed in all booth locations.

Artist Breakfast

Join us Sunday morning, August 24th, from 7:45am to 9am for a complimentary breakfast for participating artists! We will also announce the award winners at that time. Come to the south plaza of the Port Clinton building, near where our office is located!

Peer Review

All artists are subject to a peer review during the festival.

Art Festival Gift Cards

To stimulate art buying at the festival, Amdur Productions sells and gives away \$25 gift cards to attendees! Please honor the \$25 gift card as payment. Patrons must use each \$25 gift card in whole and not in part (no change is given). Then fill out your name on the gift card and bring it to an Amdur Productions' staff member. We will reimburse you the amount with cash right at the festival!

Bring A Water Bottle!

In an initiative to be eco-friendly and reduce our carbon footprint, instead of plastic water bottles, we will have a water refill station in our festival office.
